Tues 1st	For our government & MPs as turmoil & uncertainty continue within our parliament
Wed 2nd	For our youngsters who have started or returned to university and those who have entered the world of work
Thur 3rd	For Clare as she continues to recover from her recent operation
Fri 4th	For Abby, Rachel and Rebecca in Uganda as Sam is with the first response team that is coordinating getting the relief supplies and people to the Bahamas. Please pray that the planes continue to fly without any technical difficulties so they can keep up the high pace of flights each day. Please pray for all the volunteers who are working tirelessly to sort, pack and arrange all the relief supplies so they can be flown across to the Bahamas.
Sat 5th	For CPAS - This weekend the Wirral School Venture takes place near Birkenhead. After being piloted in 2016, this School Venture now takes place twice a year and has established strong links between the Church of England schools and churches involved. These links are crucial aspects of each School Venture, helping to connect children with suitable, age-appropriate programmes offered by churches in their area after the residential, and also setting or strengthening the platform for churches to partner effectively with their local schools.
Sun 6th	For our Harvest service giving thanks for all that we have and praying for those places where the harvest has failed or will be insufficient to meet people's needs & for our Mission Gift day as we remember those missionary societies we particularly support (MAF, CPAS, Sovereign World Trust, CrossTeach, Education for Life)

Tues 8th	Sovereign World Trust - <i>Richard Wallis of MP-UK is working on a book on Christian marriage - an important issue, but one for which it is important to be culturally attuned. Many books that fit well with the UK situation would be quite inappropriate for say Africa and India. Please pray for those with whom he is consulting, collaborating and taking advice</i>
Wed 9th	For Linnea, Graham, Bella & Lincoln as they settle into life in Sweden
Thur 10th	For the meeting of representatives of ACTS (Anglican Churches Together in Southborough) discovering ways of working together as a group ministry
Fri 11th	For the team running the youth club tonight, that they might have opportunities to interact with the youngsters in meaning ways
Sat 12th	There are strict limitations on ministry in North Korea but foreign NGOs, both Korean and Western, are active through aid and development projects. The very presence of believers can make a difference in many lives through this 'ground force'. But there is also an 'air force'. Radio is

	able to reach into North Korea, and despite many radios being pretuned to government stations, greater numbers of tuneable radios from China are making their way into the country. Pray for the impact of Reach Beyond gospel broadcasts that are transmitted via shortwave radio from Australia, and more opportunities for local people to tune in. (Reach Beyond)
Sun 13th	For the children and youth groups meeting today that God would help the youngsters to understand his word and his purpose for their lives
Mon 14th	For those recently bereaved, injured and made homeless by the hurricane crossing the Caribbean & east coast of America
Tues 15th	For the stories that have hit the headlines this week, for the people or situations involved
Wed 16th	For Mission Aviation Fellowship - For the approximately two million people who live on the island of Bhola in Bangladesh, life is defined by hardship. With practically no medical facilities or social provision available, Bhola's name: 'forgotten place,' is sadly apt. Thank the Lord for the work of Bhola's Children UK, a NGO that supports the orphaned and disabled children of Bhola, through cleft-lip surgeries and medical help, sign-language lessons, academic education and life skills such as farming and cooking. Pray that through the support these children receive, they can grow up to live full and healthy lives. (Mission Aviation Fellowship)
Thur 17th	For Jim and the team out in TW tonight with Street Pastors
Fri 18th	For our Bishop James as he oversees the diocese & as he portrays Christian values within parliament
Sat 19th	For those in our congregation who are sick, recovering from treatment or operations who need to know God's healing touch at this time
Sun 20th	For our worship today to be spirit filled and that each of us will know God better and feel His touch on our lives in a special way
Mon 21st	For a time of relaxation for teachers on half term this week & for safety for the youngsters
Tues 22nd	Please pray for political stability in Haiti.
