Sat 9th	Getting God's Word into North Korea remains an extraordinary challenge; pray for current efforts to be fruitful. Pray for technological solutions where importing paper Bibles is impossible. Ask for Spirit-led understanding of God and His ways among those with access to even a carefully preserved page of a Bible. May His Word give deep comfort to the suffering. Some North Korean refugees have (amazingly) managed to flee the country and are trekking across Asia to find a new and safe place to call home; pray that they would meet Christians and be lovingly welcomed. Pray also for the Korean women and children who have been drawn all too easily into slavery in China. (Platform 67)
Sun 10th	Remembrance Sunday- Today when our nation remembers in particular those who have died during World Wars, pray for those who are still giving their lives so that we might have freedom and for their families.
Mon 11th	<i>CrossTeach they write - We're very excited about a new opportunity to explore working in Sevenoaks schools. We're so thankful to be able to partner with the local church there as we seek to work together to share the good news of Christ in schools. Tues 19th	People belonging to most of the 19 distinct indigenous groups in Paraguay live and die with almost no access to God's good news. SIM Paraguay is addressing this by partnering with other missions to record scriptures and Bible materials in the heart languages of these communities. By sending ministry teams to disciple and train believers from indigenous communities, we pray that as leaders, these indigenous believers will, in turn, effectively convey the gospel to other groups. Wed 20th	Education for Life - Pray for children struggling with reading. Parents and teachers work hand in hand to give their children the best chance at understanding and practising one to one.
Thur 21st	For Jim out with the street Pastors tonight patrolling and caring and especially helping in different ways, as folk are out enjoying themselves. Do pray for the teams. A radio message from CCTV can suddenly bring a big change and mean they could be involved with difficult situations.
Fri 22nd	For the prayer collection team visiting the residents of Lady's Gift Road
Sat 23rd	For those feeling 'under attack' at present, that God will strengthen and encourage them
Sun 24th	For Messy Church meeting this afternoon, for the leaders as they interact with those attending, that God will be in the midst of all the activities
